## Teacher Angel

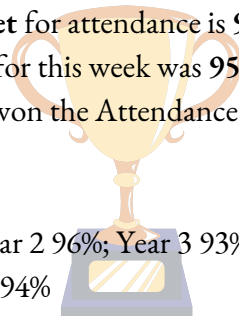

## Nursery

Can you explain the life cycle of a plant?

What does a plant need to grow?

What happened in the story 'Titch'?

## Reception

English: Can you sing the Tiny Seed Song that we learnt as you go through each event that takes place in the story?

Maths: What is the name of a 2D shape with 8 sides and 8 vertices?

Topic: What is the name of the 'family' that the frog is a part of? Can you think of any other types of animals in this 'family'?

## Year 1

RE: What is the Torah?

Phonics: Can you write 5 words with the split digraph u-e?

English: Can you add the suffix -ing to the following verbs?: stand, laugh, run, dance
