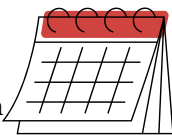
The sessions are aimed at children up to 12 years old. All children must be accompanied throughout the session by a responsible adult.

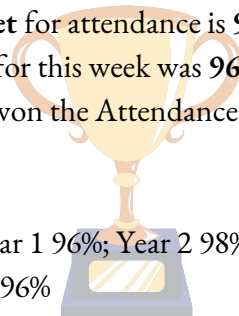

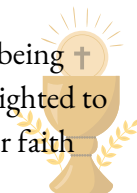
## Teacher Angel

# What Three Questions?

## Nursery

Can you explain the life cycle of a butterfly?

Can you name/draw five foods that the caterpillar ate in the story, 'The Hungry Caterpillar'?

Can you tell someone in your house the steps when planting peas? What do plants need to grow?

## Reception

English: can you create your own leaflet at home and include information about something you are interested in? Don't forget to include a front cover

Maths: what is the difference between 2D and 3D shapes?

Topic 'Our Wonderful World': what is the name of the process where a caterpillar changes into a butterfly? Meta....

## Year 1

Maths: Find 3 objects and weigh them. What is the heaviest? What is the lightest?

English: Can you use the present tense to write what you can do on the weekend?

Geography: What are the features of your local area?

## Year 2

Science: Can you construct a 'paper tube' life cycle?

Maths: What strategy can you use to double 2-digit numbers?

English: Which adjectives would you use to describe yourself?

## Year 3

Science: How does spore dispersal occur through asexual reproduction?

Computing: How do you resize an object in three dimensions using tinkercad?
