## Message from the PTA - Big Auction

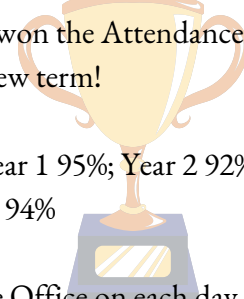
This year's Big Auction is fast approaching! The Q&A document should answer all your questions, but here are the key dates! Tickets for the evening are available on ParentMail.

## Nursery

RE : What role does a donkey play in the Easter story?

Phonics : What two new Tricky Words did we learn this week and can you put them into a sentence?

Maths: What is double 1? What is double 2?

## Year 1

English: What is an adverb?

Maths: How many pieces are in halves and quarters?

Science: What are the 5 animal families?
