Thank you so much to everyone who came to enjoy the Open House yesterday evening! It was an incredible showcase of the children's hard work across the year. A huge thank you to all the staff for teaching the children, and a special thank you to Miss Hodgson for coordinating the evening.

## SATs outcomes

Year 6 received their SATs outcomes on Tuesday. We are incredibly proud of them! 69% of them met age related expectations in reading, writing and maths (combined), which is higher than the national level. 17% of them achieved the higher standard in all 3 areas, which puts us in the top 10% nationally.

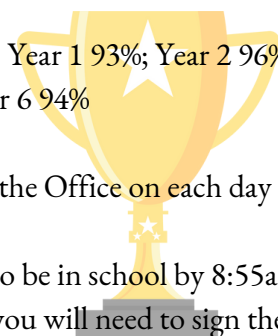

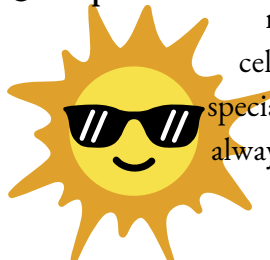
