### Online Safety guide

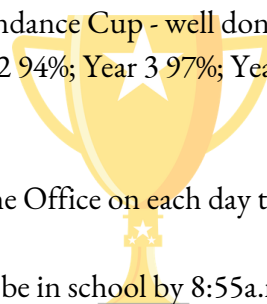
This week's guide is about online trends encouraging violence.

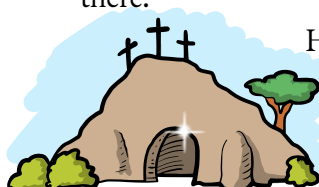
## Miss Whitehead
