# What Three Questions?

## Nursery

Literacy: How did the characters in the Pumpkin Soup story work out their differences?

Maths: Can you sing '5 little speckled frogs' with a family member and show the number of frogs that are left using your fingers?

## Reception

Literacy: What words rhyme with cat?

Maths: Can you write the numbers 1-10?

Topic: What would you like to be when you grow up?

## Year 1

Maths: Why are teen numbers special?

Computing: Can you name all of the parts of a computer?

Phonics: Can you write all of the phase 5 tricky words?

## Year 2

Computing: What are 3 rules for staying safe online?

Geography: What are the differences between your home and homes in Mugurameno?

English: What do we need to include in our writing when creating stories?

## Year 3

Maths: Can you find half of 30, 24 and 13?

Art: How would you describe stained glass windows?
