Dear Year 1 Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Year 1! Starting Year 1 is a major milestone for children and we are excited to be part of your child's journey during this important transition from Farly Years to Year One.

Reading

Your child should read their phonics book every day at home. They should bring their phonics book it into school every day so we can keep track of their reading. We will change phonics books on Friday. Your child will also bring home a reading for pleasure book, and this can be changed every day if desired.

Homework

Homework will be set on Mathletics and Google Classroom every Wednesday and should be completed by Sunday. Homework should be submitted digitally through Google Classroom.

The termly project is optional, but children are highly encouraged to take part in it. Information is on Google Classroom.

PE Day

Our PE Day is on Thursday. Please ensure your child comes into school in their PE kit.

Water bottles and clothing

Children need to bring a water bottle every day. All water bottles, cardigans, jumpers and book bags should be labelled.
